

## November 2019



**1.** Pray for wisdom as we continue to see an increase in the demand for solar power so that we can make wise decisions. Also pray for the Lord's guidance as we are looking for an electrician.



**2.** Today our team gathers for a day of teaching, reflection and fellowship. Pray for a blessed day for all of us and that we have good fellowship and get new strength.

**3.** Pray for the work permit process for the van Middendorp family. The documents they have sent from the Netherlands in mid-September, haven't arrived yet and it's delaying the whole process.



**4.** Pray for the Mogulu Solar Project as we are preparing for a very remote and challenging solar installation.

**5.** Praise God for the additional storage space we have found to rent in Goroka. It will help us especially for the solar department so we can store solar panels and batteries to have them ready for installations.

**6.** Pray for strength, safety and good health for our workshop team as they install 11 HF Radios in the Telefomin area.



**7.** Continue to pray for the Wakefield and Ward families as they continue to settle back into their home countries and culture.

**8.** Praise God for the companies like Oil Search who are always willing to help us with medivacs.

**9.** Pray for the solar kits coming from Thailand that they will arrive safely.

**10.** Praise God that we were able to make some contact with the community in Rabaraba (Alotau) where we are planning to install an HF radio in a very remote place. Pray that the logistics will work out, even though communication with the pastor is difficult.



**11.** Pray for David Feka who is struggling with health issues. Pray for wisdom for the doctor and for David to make good choices to support his health.

**12.** Keep praying for our former CRMF staff. We know of some who are struggling with marriage problems and other issues. We pray that they are able to set their focus on God and seek His will.

**13.** Praise God for the partnership with Wycliffe Associates in the translation work. Pray for wisdom as we deal with the logistics to send translation kits (tablets and solar).

**14.** Praise God that the power meters for the new staff accommodation have arrived and are now installed. We waited quite a while for them to come.

**15.** Pray for wisdom as the Management Team analyse and make decisions on staff training for 2020.

**16.** Praise God for keeping us safe and accident free and continue to pray for our safety.

**17.** Pray that with God's help, we may be able to share His love in and around the communities we live in (extended family, neighbours, on the street etc). Pray that people will be transformed and see Jesus through us.

**18.** Pray for wisdom as we choose the communities who have the highest priorities for HF radio repairs. (sponsored by MAF International)



**19.** Praise God for contact with the NGO group called THOR (The Hand of Rescue), who are willing to help fly CRMF technicians into Rabaraba, Milne Bay Province. Pray for wisdom as we are making plans to partner together.

**20.** Pray that God will bring the right people to be recruited to cover vacant positions.



**21.** Praise God for the continuing orders on Audio Bibles and that God's Word will transform the lives of the listeners.

**22.** Today is MAF Day of Prayer. Join us in prayer for the work of MAF all around the world.



**23.** Pray for the issues of accommodation for our CRMF staff. It is difficult and very expensive to rent a house in town and CRMF can't provide enough housing for all the staff.

**24.** Pray for the safe and smooth arrival of the CRMF container coming from Brisbane.

**25.** Praise God for the good period of sales we have had and continue to have.



**26.** Pray for the Connect 2020 conference, that God will give us wisdom and knowledge as we plan to host with MAF PNG and CLTC.

**27.** Pray for God's favour on the customs and immigration so that the Audio Bibles can be duty and tax free when coming into the country.

**28.** Currently we are going through the end of the year stock-take. Please pray for our team for strength and good concentration as we are counting and controlling our stock.

**29.** Pray that we could recruit 3 more staff for Tek Ministries (formally known as the LT department, recently has had a name change)

**30.** Pray that the printed and audio bibles distributed out of the Bible Box from MAF planes, will continue to flow and that those remote rural communities who are hungry for the Bibles can be transformed both spiritually and physically in the name of Jesus because of the Bibles.
